When are children given homework?

Children are given a homework project every half term; they can choose to complete at least four activities from a selection. A copy of the homework grid can be found overleaf and on our class webpage. It's also expected that they read their reading book each week, and access the Timetables Rock Stars APP to practise their times tables. Additional homework is available if you feel your child would benefit from it. If this is the case, please speak to your class teacher.

When does my child change their reading book?

We will send reading folders home as soon as we've assessed your child's reading. They will be sent home on a Monday and they should be returned by Friday. Children may bring their reading books back daily, or even keep the same book for more than a week if they haven't finished it. Unfortunately we cannot change your child's book if they don't bring it back!

How do I send money into school?

We are a cashless school. Everything must be paid for through Parent Pay.



Is there any breakfast or afterschool provision?

Breakfast club is open from 7:50am and can be accessed by all children. After-school club operates daily throughout term time from 3:00pm until 5:30pm.. Both Breakfast and After School clubs can be paid for via Parent Pay.

There are a wide and varying range of after school and lunchtime activities on offer, which are led by staff and are free of charge to our children. These clubs differ termly and include options such as: cookery, sewing, dance, gymnastics, art, music, ICT and a wide range of different sports.

My child is unhappy or having problems with other children...

Your first port of call is the class teacher; usually things can be nipped in the bud straight away. It's vital that the teacher is told about any issues immediately, so they can be sorted out. Please refrain from using social media to air your concerns, as this can cause further unnecessary issues; and can be quite unhelpful!
