What time are the Nursery sessions?

Morning Nursery

- 8.45am – 11.30am

Afternoon Nursery

- 12.30pm – 3pm
- Nursery children must be brought to school and collected by an appropriate adult and handed over to the classteacher. Children of this age must not be left unsupervised.
- Children arrive and leave through the Nursery gate and yard.
- Only parents of pupils in the Resourced Provisions or with a disabled badge may use the school car park. Nearby parking can be found in Lidl and Asda.



What should my child wear?

Boys/Girls Uniform

- Black or grey trousers, skirts or pinafores (not jogging pants or leggings)
- A plain white collared polo shirt
- A green Alexandra jumper or cardigan
- **Plain** black shoes – we love velcro! (no coloured soles or laces)
- In the Summer, a green ‘Gingham’ summer dress or tailored school shorts may be worn
- No jewellery other than small studs

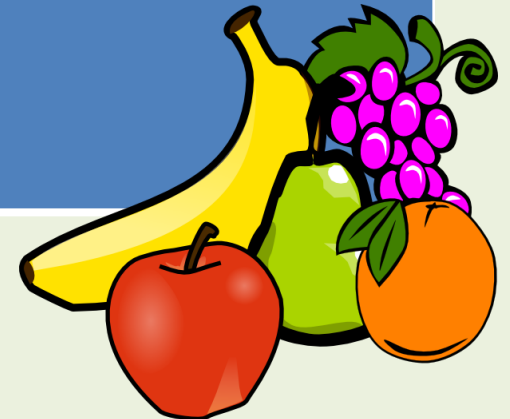

What will my child eat at school?

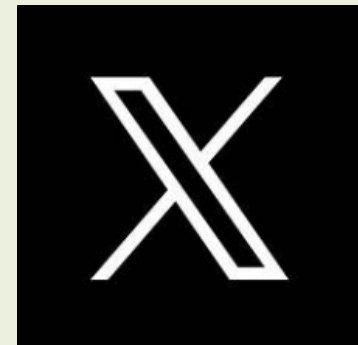
- Nursery children will be provided with free milk during the sessions.
- They also have a named water bottle which is kept in school that they can access whenever they want throughout the session.
- Children need to bring in a snack to have during the session these can include:

Fresh fruit
Fresh vegetables
Vegetable sticks with hummus
Bread sticks
Squeezy yoghurts
Sugar free jelly
Dried fruit such as raisins
Cheese
Crackers



How will I stay in contact?

- Seesaw is an app where you can directly message teachers.
- You will also see photos about what your child gets up to each day.
- An invite and QR code will be sent to your email address so you can join the app.
- Teachers will always make time to speak to you before or after school.

Can my child stay full time?

- Acorns Wrap Around Care is available so that children can be in school all day from 9am -3pm.
- **This is run separately from school by Active Childcare**
- Cost is £16 per day.

How can I book lunch for my child?

- If your child is staying all day they will need to have lunch. They can bring a packed lunch with them or order a school dinner at a cost of £2.40 per day.
- To book a school lunch for you child you will have to log on and pay for dinners via Parent Pay. You can be set up with a Parent Pay account in September.

Can my child go to Breakfast and After School club?

- We have Breakfast Club available daily in our school hall. It is from 7.50am -8.30am at a small charge.
- Conkers After School Club is also available daily and again run separately to school by Little Oaks.

What if my child has medical needs?

- We have a medicine policy in school which is to be followed if your child needs any medication.
- If your child has an inhaler please make sure you get a spare inhaler and spacer to remain in school.
- **During the Meet the Teacher sessions please let us know about any allergies or medication that your child has.**



What if my child isn't toilet trained?

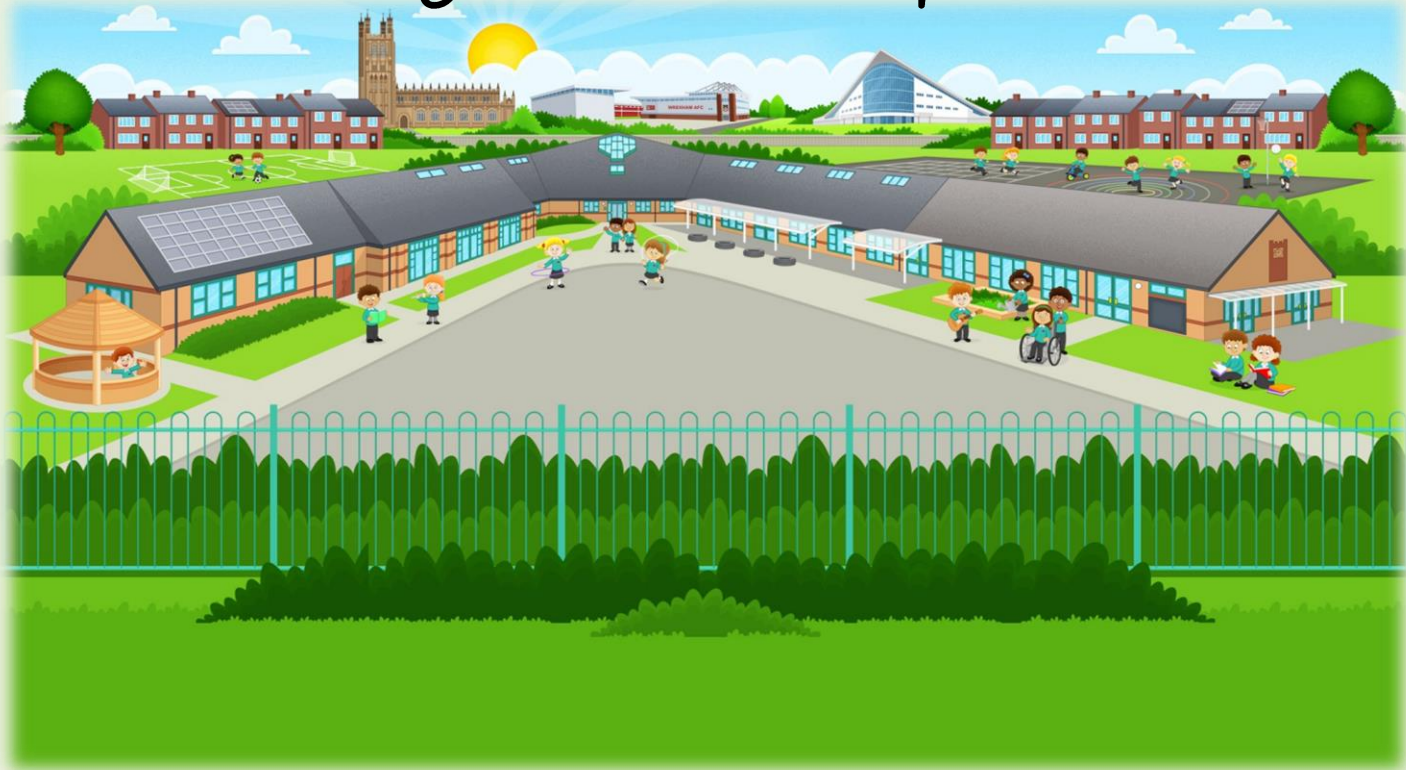
- We advise getting your child toilet trained before they start Nursery however if however, if despite your best efforts, his hasn't been possible due to medical or developmental delays, please talk to us and we will do our best to support you.
- Your child can bring a bag with spares which can be kept in their locker and we will them to be an independent as possible.



How else can I support my child with starting school?

- Can they communicate their needs?
- Ask when they need a drink or need to go to the toilet? Get into their snacks or access their drink bottle independently?
- Able to make friends with other children?
- Can they take their shoes and coat on and off independently?
- Children may be nervous or reluctant to ask for help at first so practice over the Summer Holidays with getting your child to say “Can you help me?”
