



# Dosbarth Walnut Autumn 1 Homework Grid

Please spend quality time with your child completing some activities on this grid. There are 6 activities in total to work through; we expect your child to complete **at least 4** by **Friday 24<sup>th</sup> October**. All activities have 3 'layers' that learners can choose to complete. For example they can choose the **must, should or could** statement for each activity—or even complete them all! Some homework activities are available to complete via Google Classroom. Children access this by logging into their Hwb accounts.

## Languages

### Super Fact Files

**Could:** Create a fact file with headings: Name, Power, Likes, Costume. Share on Seesaw.

**Should:** Write 2-3 sentences about your superhero (e.g., "She can fly. He is kind.").

**Must:** Draw a picture of your superhero and label it with their name.

## Mathematics

### Superhero Numbers

**Could:** Create a superhero number challenge - e.g., write sums with your badge number or complete a "Superhero Times Table" for 2s/5s/10s.

**Should:** Practise writing your numbers carefully up to 20 or 100.

**Must:** Count groups of superhero objects (e.g., toys, Lego, stars).

## Health and Wellbeing

### Superhero Training

**Could:** Create and try out your own Superhero Training Plan - 5 different moves (e.g., star jumps, squats, running on the spot, balances, stretches). Record yourself showing one.

**Should:** With your family, do a short workout or mindfulness session together (e.g., Cosmic Kids Yoga, GoNoodle, or a family walk). Share how you felt afterwards.

**Must:** Teach someone at home one superhero move you know (e.g., a balance, stretch, or jump) and practise it together.

## Expressive Arts

### Super Creations

**Could:** Create a piece of superhero artwork (drawing, painting, or digital). Add it to Seesaw and explain your choices.

**Should:** Design a superhero cape using paper/fabric and decorate it with your initials.

**Must:** Make a superhero mask or badge using any materials you have at home.

## Science & Technology

### Super Gadgets

**Could:** Build a simple gadget or model using recycling/junk modelling. Take a photo or video and explain what it does on Seesaw.

**Should:** Show or tell how your gadget works. You could record yourself giving the instructions or act it out like an advert for your gadget.

**Must:** Draw your superhero gadget and add labels (e.g., "button," "laser," "net").

## Humanities

### Heroes in Real Life

**Could:** Create a Real-Life Hero Fact File about someone who inspires you.

**Should:** Write 2-3 sentences about someone you think is a hero in real life (nurse, firefighter, family member).

**Must:** Talk to someone at home about who their hero is and why. Draw a picture of them.
