Driver AoLE	Topic Overview:	Hook/Experiences
Languages, Literacy and Communication	<p>This half term, children will become trainee superheroes at 'Super Me Academy'. They'll start by settling in, making friends, and learning routines before diving into their superhero training. Children will design their superhero costumes, masks, and gear, and take part in fun missions and challenges that build teamwork, problem-solving, healthy habits, and emotional skills.</p> <p>Each week, they'll earn superhero badges to show the skills and strengths they're developing. Activities include obstacle courses, creative design, coding challenges, and acts of kindness. The topic will finish with a Superhero Graduation Parade, where children celebrate their achievements and showcase their superhero selves.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Super Me Academy Arrival - Children arrive to find the classroom transformed into Super Me Academy HQ. Mysterious packages, superhero masks, badges, and "mission briefings" are scattered around, inviting children to join the superhero training. A video message from the Academy explains that new recruits are needed to complete exciting missions and discover their unique powers. • Weekly Superhero Missions - Each week, children are given a new challenge to build their superhero skills, such as obstacle courses to test agility, creative design tasks to make costumes and gadgets, teamwork challenges to rescue "citizens," and coding or problem-solving missions to unlock new powers. • Hero Training Workshop - Children explore materials, design their superhero gear, and plan creative solutions in teams, using art, construction kits, and digital tools. • Superhero Graduation Parade - The topic culminates in a celebration where children showcase their costumes, gadgets, and badges, sharing their achievements with peers and families.
