Humanities	<p>This half term, children will become time explorers, travelling through different periods to uncover lessons from the past. They'll begin by exploring their own personal history and timelines, before stepping into the Victorian era to compare life "then and now." Finally, they'll journey back millions of years to discover the world of dinosaurs and the evidence they left behind.</p> <p>Through the story 'The Enormous Turnip', children will build their storytelling and writing skills, in maths they'll develop confidence with addition and subtraction through fun, practical activities, including adding and subtracting turnips and measuring dinosaurs!</p> <p>By exploring change over time, comparing objects and evidence and creating art inspired by the past, children will develop curiosity, historical thinking and a deeper understanding of how the past shapes our present.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time Travel Launch Day: Children climb into the class "time machine" to travel through history!
