Driver AoLE	Topic Overview:	Hook/Experiences
Mathematics & Numeracy	Dragon's Den for Seeds focuses on early engagement, communication for purpose, and functional numeracy through highly sensory, play-based enterprise experiences. Learners explore choice-making, cause and effect, counting through routines, capacity play, and early money concepts, alongside developing independence, regulation, and shared attention.	• Sensory exploration of products and materials (bracelets, beads, textures). • Making choices between preferred items. • Role-play giving, taking, buying, selling. • Water play, planting, cooking and sensory experiences.

Literacy:

- I can communicate choices through gesture, eye-gaze, symbols, objects or vocalisation.
- I can respond to familiar stories, songs and repeated language.
- I can show understanding of persuasive language linked to real objects (e.g. favourite item).
- I can join in with repeated phrases, signs or actions.
- I can make marks and explore early writing during play.

Numeracy:

- I can engage with counting through play and daily routines.
- I can experience "one more" and "gone" during activities.
- I can explore full and empty, more and less through capacity play.
- I can take part in simple give/take exchanges.
- I can help sort or group objects during play or voting activities.

Health & Wellbeing:

- I can show likes and dislikes using my preferred method of communication.
- I can begin to regulate my emotions with adult support.
- I can take part in shared activities and simple turn-taking.
- I can follow familiar routines and feel safe within them.
- I can explore food safely during cooking activities.
- I can take part in movement activities that develop body awareness and coordination.

Cymraeg:

(Welsh language learning can be naturally embedded through bilingual signage, greetings, and role-play phrases.)

- I can respond to familiar Welsh words and instructions.
- I can join in with counting and colour words in Welsh through songs and routines.

RVE:

- I can experience kindness, fairness and turn-taking.
- I can feel safe, valued and included during shared activities.

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Science & Technology:

- I can explore materials through sensory investigation.
- I can notice changes in plants, water and materials.
- I can follow simple first-then routines.
- I can use simple technology with adult support (photos, videos, switches).

Humanities:

- I can experience familiar roles through play (shop, café).
- I can begin to understand belonging within a group or routine.

Expressive Arts:

- I can explore colour, texture, sound and movement.
- I can create with support using a range of materials.
- I can show preferences within creative activities.
