Please spend quality time with your child completing some activities on this grid. There are 6 areas in total to work through; we expect your child to complete **at least 4** by **17th October 2025**. All activities have 3 'layers' that learners can choose to complete. For example they can choose the must, should or could statement for each activity—or even complete them all!

Languages, Literacy and Communication Wonderful Writing

Could: Interview a friend or family member and write a short paragraph about them

Should: Write 5 full sentences in Welsh about yourself, e.g. Dw i'n ... (My name is...) Dw i'n byw yn... (I live in...)

Must: Create a "This is me" poster and add at least 5 Welsh words to describe

Mathematics and Numeracy My Maths

Could: Set and achieve a personal times tables target (e.g. practise 7s until I can say them in under 30 seconds).

Should: Measure your height, hand span, foot length, and compare to family members.

Must: Create a maths about me poster which includes: Age, shoe size, number of pets, favourite number, family members etc.

Health and Wellbeing Family Meals

Could: Work with an adult to prepare a healthy meal for your family.

Should: Research a healthy recipe you could make for your family.

Must: Go outside and explore your local community. Write 5 interesting things you find.

Expressive Arts Express yourself!

Could: Research a graffiti/mural artist and create a mural based on their ideas and style

Should: Create a small mural design on paper that represents you

Must: Design your name in a graffiti style

Science and Technology Healthy body, healthy mind

Could: Create an animation promoting healthy eating.

Should: Make a short video using adobe about the family recipe you have chosen.

Must: Create a podcast by interviewing someone in your household about healthy choices.

Humanities My Community and Me

Could: Create your own mural which represents the history of Wrexham or Wales.

Should: Pick a local landmark (e.g. Racecourse Ground or St Giles Church) and find out when it was built, why its important and who might visit it today.

Must: Draw a simple map of your street or local area in Wrexham. Include important places like schools, shops and parks.
