



# Blwyddyn 5/6 Homework Grid – Cynefin

Please spend quality time with your child completing some activities on this grid. There are 6 areas in total to work through; we expect your child to complete **at least 4** by **20th March 2026**. All activities have 3 'layers' that learners can choose to complete. For example they can choose the must, should or could statement for each activity—or even complete them all!

## Languages, Literacy and Communication

- Could:** Write and perform a spoken-word poem persuading others that Wrexham is a place that should be valued, protected and celebrated.
- Should:** Create a poem or descriptive piece for visitors explaining what makes Wrexham and its community important to you and other children.
- Must:** Write a short Cynefin poem about a place in Wrexham that is special to you.

## Mathematics and Numeracy

- Could:** Write three real-life word problems based on life in Wrexham and solve them.
- Should:** Play Times Tables Rock Stars at least twice this week and challenge someone in your year group.
- Must:** Create a 100-square and colour in three different times tables. What patterns do you notice?

## Health and Wellbeing

- Could:** Design a poster that makes people feel welcome about coming into Wrexham.
- Should:** Find and list any food/items in your home that are locally sourced or come from Wales.
- Must:** Do a 10-15 minute well being walk every day for a week in your local area.

## Expressive Arts

- Could:** Create a monument/statue that links with Wrexham and its culture.
- Should:** Visit Wrexham town centre and identify five things you can experience with each of your five senses.
- Must:** Take 10 photos of famous landmarks in Wrexham.

## Science and Technology

- Could:** Create an interactive build in Minecraft Education where the player must make good choices for the community or environment
- Should:** Use Minecraft Education to build a model of a real place in Wrexham and show how people use it.
- Must:** Choose one place in Wrexham. Research and record two facts about how it supports people or nature in the community.

## Humanities

- Could:** Create a fact file about a famous person from Wrexham and explain how they are important to the community.
- Should:** Compare an online map of Wrexham from 100 years ago to today and describe three key changes.
- Must:** Find one interesting fact about the history of Wrexham and write a short paragraph explaining why it matters.
