



Blwyddyn 5/6 Homework Grid – Disasters



Please spend quality time with your child completing some activities on this grid. There are 6 areas in total to work through; we expect your child to complete **at least 4** by **15th May 2026**. All activities have 3 'layers' that learners can choose to complete. For example they can choose the must, should or could statement for each activity—or even complete them all!

Languages, Literacy and Communication

Could: Write a story involving a fatal disaster, incorporating words from your established word bank.

Should: Write a script and record an educational video about famous disasters throughout history.

Must: Watch a YouTube video of a natural disaster (earthquake, tornado, hurricane, etc.) and create a word bank of adjectives to describe it.

Mathematics and Numeracy

Must: Create a 100-square grid and highlight various times tables using different colours.

Should: Research, order, and compare the death rates of five different disasters.

Could: Use a Venn diagram to compare the specific effects of the Gresford and Aberfan mining disasters.

Health and Wellbeing

Could: Create a shoebox model of your den using clean recycling materials from home.

Should: Draw a plan of your den and label it.

Must: Build your own survival shelter/den to protect you at home from a natural disaster. Tweet us your pictures,

Expressive Arts

Could: Sketch the landscape of Aberfan after the coal mine disaster. Use paints or pastels to add subtle colour

Should: Create a collage of the landscape after a disaster has occurred.

Must: Follow tutorial on "How to Draw a Tornado!"

Science and Technology

Must: Research a list of active volcanoes worldwide and how frequently they erupt.

Should: Draw and label a diagram of a volcano.

Could: Build your own working, erupting volcano model

Humanities

Must: Research a specific deadly disaster that has impacted the planet.

Should: Label a world map and plot the locations where various disasters have occurred.

Could: Create a chronological timeline plotting 10 different disasters
